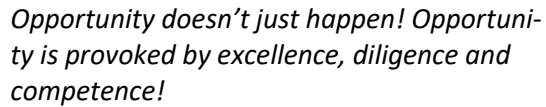

2 reasons why humility is essential

PRIDE - A feeling of exaggerated importance

PRESUMPTION - An assumption that others should regard me with a certain level of esteem.

ENTITLEMENT - The belief that I because of who I am, I should receive certain advantages

EXALTATION - the condition of elevating, promoting and advancing myself.
